A safe and fun scavenger hunt at your local parks to keep your child active and engaged!

How to ParkHunt:

1. Each park will have a downloadable map and clue sheet, painted stones around the park, and a badge to earn.
 - a. [All items can be downloaded here: https://theruniversity.com/parkhunt/](https://theruniversity.com/parkhunt/)
2. Each Hunt may have different rules or tasks. Follow the instructions that come with each map.
3. DO NOT pick up, move, or touch the stone. Other kids will be looking for them too.
4. Some hunts will have bonus activities like animals to imitate, exercises to do, trivia to answer, and problems to solve.
5. Take photos and tag #ParkHunt on Facebook or Instagram for a chance at giveaways like hooded sweatshirts, hats and more!
6. After completing the Hunt, print out your badge, attach it to cardboard and string, and wear it with pride!
7. These hunts are free for all to participate in.
 - a. However, if you had a great time, you can 'buy the Hunt Makers a cup of coffee' through Venmo, PayPal, and through the Events.com. There is no obligation here.

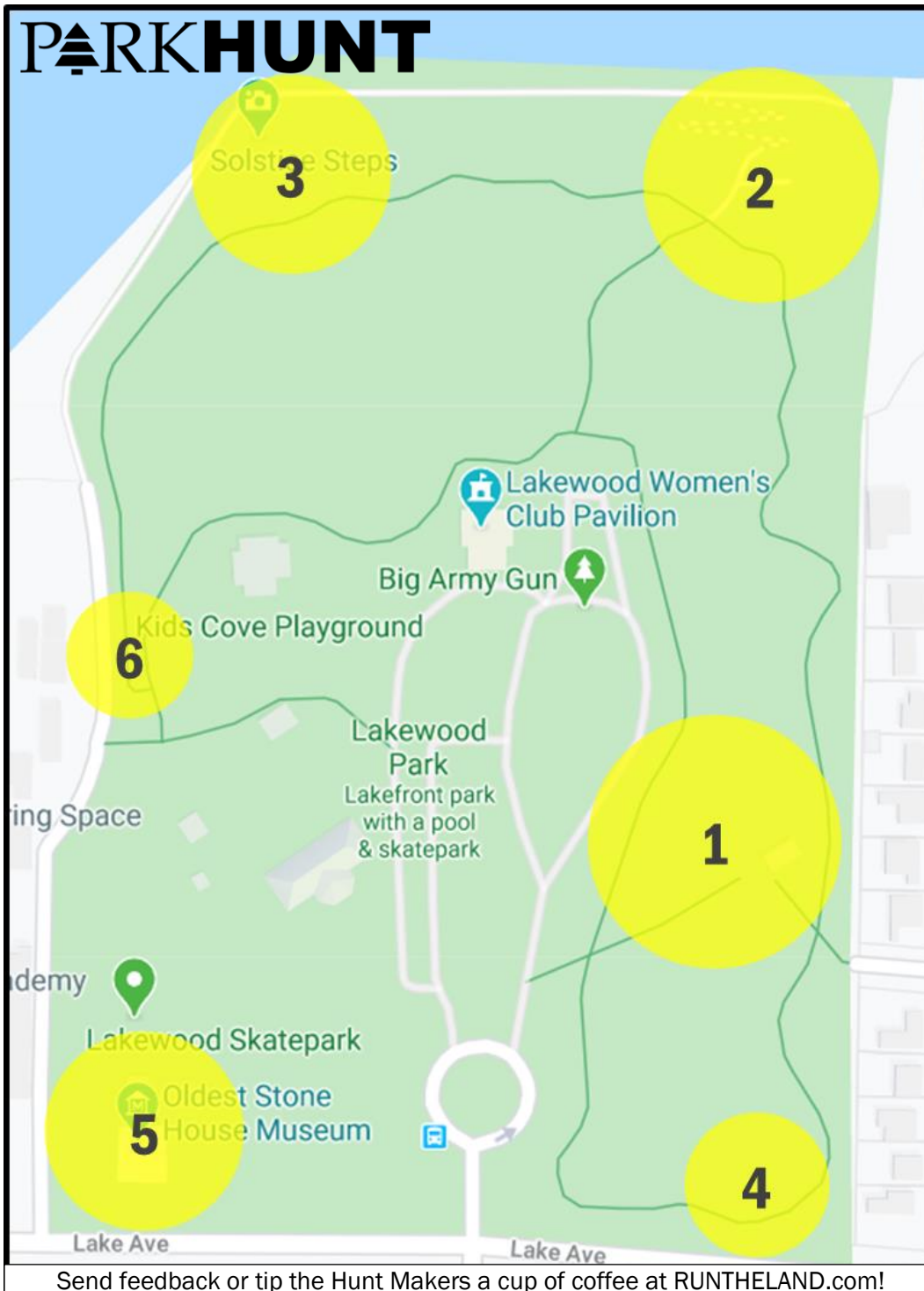

SUPER HERO HUNT (ages 3-9)

SCAVENGER HUNT at Lakewood Park

Start at #1 and follow the hints to find the painted stones!

- # 1** To the GRANDSTAND you go, buzz there like a bee.
Take a look around, especially by a TREE.
EXERCISE: Do your AGE x 2 in Jumping Jacks
Super Hero on stone: _____
- # 2** Head to the lake acting like an alligator taking a bite,
And while standing on the LAKEWOOD, OHIO sign, look over to your RIGHT
EXERCISE: Do your AGE in Push-Ups
Super Hero on stone: _____
- # 3** Just skip on down the promenade along the Erie coast,
And keep a watchful eye, particularly near a LIGHT POST
EXERCISE: Do your AGE x 2 in toe-touches
Super Hero on stone: _____
- # 4** Now race across the park, you have a ways to go,
Better to go fast, as that's more fun than slow.
EXERCISE: Hold a plank for your AGE x 2
Super Hero on stone: _____
- # 5** Flap your arms like a bird over to the Old Stone House,
And harness your inner animal and search there like a mouse.
EXERCISE: Do as many somersaults as your AGE
Super Hero on stone: _____
- # 6** The last stone to find! But where could it be?
While acting like a monkey, look up into a TREE.
EXERCISE: Do as many cartwheels as your AGE
Super Hero on stone: _____

How to PARKHUNT

1. Start at the LOWEST number and go in order
2. Look for a painted stone with a character on it in the area shown
 - a. Please, **DO NOT TOUCH OR MOVE THE STONE** after you find it. Other kids will be looking for it too.
3. Write down the name of the character you find on each stone
4. Complete each hint until you get to the final stone.
5. Go home and print your medal! You did it!

Medal and Instructions

How to Print and Wear your ParkHunt Medal:

1. Print this page
2. Paste a small square of cardboard behind the design to make it more sturdy
3. Cut around the circle of the medal
4. Use a hole-punch to put a hole in the top of the medal
 - a. You may also tape the ribbon to the back of the medal for a different look
5. Weave through a piece of string or ribbon approximately 24 inches
6. Tie the ribbon and wear around your neck!
